Another reporter mentions the fable sphere at it's peak as renderings highlight the design **REPORTER** 3 Inspired by Chinese folklore; the Dragon's Pearl. The skyscraper has the architectural world buzzing. Cut to a shot of a man taking a picture with his daughter on his shoulders. Followed by city level shot as the Pearl forms in a 3D rendering. We hear the familiar voice of the first architect as we transition to building schematics. ARCHITECT 1 This building, it's about a new kind of public amenity for the city. Cut to a male reporter covering the Pearl in VO. B-roll of the hotel, restaurants, and shopping area are featured. Until he closes his report out to camera.



REPORTER 1 It has a five-star hotel, restaurants, shopping, but most importantly, space.

Cut to drawings of the interior park and live action footage of the park as the reporter continues in VO.

REPORTER 1 (CONT'D) Featuring a thirty story vertical park at the buildings center.

As we pull away from the building the original architect comments again.

ARCHITECT 1 It's changed the relationship between us, and buildings.

The reporter continues over a graphic comparison of the Pearl and other large skyscrapers. We get a real idea of its scale.

Cut to b-roll of lifestyle moments as the architect continues to romanticize our relationship with structures.

> ARCHITECT 1 Buildings shape our society. Better buildings, better cities, and a better world.

Cut to a news anchor in the studio. The Pearl is featured PIP as she delivers her report. Cutting to footage of the massive Pearl at the top as she continues in VO.

ANCHOR 3

Plans to open the buildings upper half remain on track. And Xiao Ming Ji will reveal the purpose of the mysterious sphere at the Pearl's grand opening ...
